I write to you at the start our New Year, 2025, a year that is sure to be full of both promise and challenge for those of us who follow Jesus the Christ.

Some of you will no doubt have made New Year's resolution and its always interesting to see how long people keep those resolutions.

I'm not making any resolution as 2025 begins, but I will be making a promise that is far more binding and, indeed, more than a promise and I hope and trust many of you will be making that same binding promise.

I refer, of course, to the annual Methodist Covenant Service and the promise we make to God within that service, a service that has been described as one of the jewels in the Methodist crown.

The Covenant promise can be scary to some people. In the past I have spoken to Methodists who go to Covenant Service but feel they cannot make the promise - they see it as too binding, as giving too much, and are not sure they can keep it.

The Covenant can be dangerous promise to make in my case led to my being called to

Methodist ministry, totally disrupting my life, changing everything.

The Covenant promise is a promise to be disciples of Jesus. It is a promise to give everything we have and everything we are to him. It is a promise to put Jesus first, to make him the Lord of our lives.

I wrote earlier that some find this promise difficult to make and all of us find it very difficult to keep. We make the promise in good faith, we want to keep it, but how do we do that?

Jesus said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a person remains in me and I in them they will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."

The secret to discipleship is to focus on Jesus. If all our focus is on Jesus then we can be his true disciples because he will give us the strength and power that we need to succeed.

We focus on Jesus by reading the Bible, especially the gospels. We focus on Jesus by praying regularly. We focus on Jesus by worshipping regularly in fellowship with other Christians.

I know from experience that the more I do these things the easier it is to be a disciple of Jesus; the more I neglect these things the harder it becomes. We can make this Covenant promise this coming month, knowing that if we focus on Jesus he will help us to keep it.
